SUBJECT: Temporarily sending out *HIV-1/2 Antigen and Antibody screen with Reflex to HIV-1/2 Antibody Differentiation* testing due to manufacturer issues

Effective 04/08/26, DLS temporarily will be sending out all orders for *HIV-1/2 Antigen and Antibody screen with Reflex to HIV-1/2 Antibody Differentiation* testing to Quest Diagnostics Laboratories (QDL). The manufacturer for the current HIV reagent (BioRad) is having a reagent issue and will be unable to supply any lab with HIV reagent until the end of April 2026.

All orders placed as of 04/08/26 will automatically be sent to Quest Diagnostics Laboratory (QDL).

We apologize for the inconvenience, and we will bring HIV testing back in-house as soon as readily available.

The turn-around time for this test will be up to 5 days.
